ACTIVITY 3~ Improving work experience

Timing: 30 mins.

Objective:

To encourage students to reflect on the quality of their placement

Outcomes:

Students feedback their thoughts about their placement

Students make constructive suggestions for improving placements in the future

Method:

Set the context ~ emphasise that students' feedback and the best of their ideas will contribute to a revised information pack for current Year 9

Use the powerpoint questions for students to feedback their thoughts about the placement .

Highlight the importance of letting us know what they sincerely think, so that we can use their ideas to improve things.

After due discussion of a range of ideas, students should use the prompt sheet provided, "Improving Work Experience", to make positive suggestions about their placement.

Hints & tips:

Stress that their sheets will be collected in and all will be read by WEXA staff who will value constructive suggestions.
