Week 1: Introductions, Site tour, health and safety induction, PPE/cleaning/housekeeping. Tool location and description Airbag detonation demonstration. Hazardous material description and methods of safe handling.

Week 2: Vehicle maintenance - Interior removal (seats, seatbelts, dashboard, switch gear)

Week 3: Vehicle maintenance - Drivetrain removal (engine, gearbox, radiator, subframe)

Week 4: Vehicle maintenance-Tyres and wheels (tyre identification, composition, wear indicators, removal using tyre machine)


Week 5: Vehicle maintenance-Boot and bonnet (assessment for damage, safe removal and storage, removing locks, handles)

Week 6: Vehicle maintenance-Brakes and suspension (recognise and remove brake callipers. ABS sensors, driveshafts and hubs, brake master cylinders & servo)


Week 7: Vehicle maintenance-engine component identification and removal (alternator, starter motor, air conditioning pump, manifolds, turbo, injectors, cylinder head, power steering pump)

Week 8: Vehicle maintenance-removing material for recycling-wiring (copper), aluminium alloy, catalytic converters, damaged or scrap motors.
